- Represents the individual officer
- Run by law enforcement for law enforcement
- Serves the local community
- Supports local youth interested in law enforcement careers.
- Assists members during times of need
- Supports the authority with which we have been entrusted and honors those we serve

Building A Proud Tradition

- The Southern States Police Benevolent Association, Inc. is composed of more than 32,000 law enforcement officers employed by federal, state, county and municipal governments. **Dues:\$235 annually or \$282 if monthly.**
- **Legal Benefits:**
- **Attorney is selected by PBA** with approval of your local board. The SSPBA legal department will become involved, if necessary, **at the final level of appeal.**
- Shooting scene coverage or serious injuries from line-of-duty incidents
- Civil Suits: no cap or limit: PBA will assign eligible members an **attorney to monitor** the case.
- Disciplinary Representation: **The chapter board** of directors **will assess the situation and will vote on whether to provide assistance.**
- Accidental Death: Base salary if killed in line of duty; \$ 5000 if not occupational death, retired or reserve; cardiac death (with significant restrictions).
- **Benefits can change at any time at discretion of the Southern States PBA**

- The NCFOP is Comprised of over 7000 officers in the State of North Carolina and Wake County Lodge # 41 has over 80 Active members—there are 2200 lodges and over 330000 FOP members nationally.
- Active member **dues** for currently employed officers **are \$165 annually.**
- Members work as local, county, state and federal officers and your membership card allows you access to any FOP lodge in the country.
- Legal Representation: **Unlimited coverage with no cap or co-pay if a plan attorney.**
- **Legal benefits:** you receive **legal representation for ANY critical incident** (e.g. Shooting, fatal car collision or death investigation) while performing your duties as a law enforcement officer on or off duty—regardless of geography.
- Legal Representation is provided for civil or criminal lawsuits .
- **The NC State lodge represents members for Administrative actions**
- Our members are your local partners, friends and co-workers.
- Our lodge meets monthly to talk about YOUR issues with YOUR colleagues in a fraternal environment - **all members are welcome.**
- Ongoing representation at the local , county, state and national level by the FOP. (e.g HR-218)
- We are **NOT** a union but we actively represent our members and are involved In the community (e.g. Christmas With A Cop and NC Youth Trooper Programs) as well charitable support to schools and the needy in our community.
- Death benefits to your beneficiary: \$3000 for other than line of duty death / \$9000 for line of duty death. Applies to active duty personnel only.

- Only represents Raleigh Police Officers: approximately 400 officers.
- There are 10000 Teamsters in NC—not all are police officers. The International Teamsters President is not a Police Officer.
- **Dues are : \$288 annually** withdrawn for your paycheck.
- **RPPA is a local of the International Teamsters Union.** There is no right to collectively bargain.
- Advocates for better pay, benefits, improved working conditions however
- **all members are dues-paying Teamsters.**
- Legal counsel from **Teamster** Defense Fund: line of duty officer-involved shootings and criminal complaints that arise from line-of duty incidents: **they** choose the attorney.- no limit.
